## Who are we?

We are a 'not for profit' organisation.

We work in partnership with GP practices and Primary Care Networks (PCNs) in Leeds to provide and enhance sustainable health care system.

We also work in partnership with other stakeholders across Leeds.

Our services include Extended Access, NHS Health Checks, and other services which helps to enhance PCN development by supporting operational delivery and much more.

Our role includes supporting and improving where possible, the healthcare provision available to the people of Leeds.



## **GP Extended Access (EA) Service**



Leeds GP Confed is contracted to provide extended access service across the city of Leeds - seven days a week.



The EA service provides a wide range of primary care support outside the regular GP Practice opening hours.



Services are provided from 21 Hubs from Monday to Friday 6.30 – 8pm and on Saturday and Sunday until 6pm.



Appointments are available for a range of professionals GPs, Nurses, Health Care Assistants, Clinical Pharmacists, Physiotherapists, Phlebotomists and Healthy Minds Practitioners.








#### Seeking your voice and experience

#### **GP** Assembly

The GP Assembly is open to all staff from GP Practices in Leeds. We convene four times a year to share policy and changes that are relevant to you within the context of the wider health and care system. Here, we listen to and gather the insight and intelligence of general practice

#### **Engaging with Practices and PCNs**

The Confed regularly listens and acts on what we hear through our relationships with you – whether that's through our Primary Care Development Team, Extended Access colleagues, or the other forums we arrange e.g. PCN Manager's PMO. Our personal connections with you are incredibly important to us

#### **Events and collaborations**

We stage and support events and collaborations that bring you the latest information, guidance and resources. We work in partnership with organisations such as the Leeds LMC to make best use of our collective efforts to support and represent you

The Confed acts as a voice for general practice in many of the city's strategic decision-making bodies, including the Leeds Health and Wellbeing Board, the Partnership Executive Group (PEG), and Primary Care Programme Board. We support clinical leadership in the system, especially in Population and Care Boards. Our established place around these tables ensures that general practice is fundamental to directing collective resources to improve population outcomes, reduce health inequalities and the future health and care planning and delivery

**Delivering improved outcomes** 

#### Mutual aid

Confed staff offer support and mutual aid, acting an integrated partner in our citywide health and care service. We work with other providers such as LCH to ensure quality service delivery and system resilience

#### Services

The Confed designs and delivers services based on what you need and want. We work with quality providers to deliver economies of scale and with system partners to secure further benefits to general practice. We are a not-for-profit and reinvest everything back into supporting general practice

#### **Contracts**

The Confed delivers city-wide contracts on your behalf, delivering high quality care at scale, such as the Extended Access Service and NHS Health Checks. We work across all PCNs, managing employment and deployment of staff, to ensure effective provision that reduces the burden on general practice
